ORGANIZATION DESCRIPTION

Since 1971, Jamestown Community Center has been providing learning opportunities and safe spaces for low-income youth in San Francisco's Mission District. Our youth represent the low-income, racially and ethnically diverse community in which they live and attend school. Our strategy is to serve a core group of neighborhood youth with multiple, high-impact programs as they grow through a full range of programs designed to help them transition from children into confident young adults.

Jamestown Community Center and Loco Bloco merged in 2018. Both youth development organizations had long established track records of providing enriching, high-quality programming to youth. We believed that our shared commitment to youth development, our shared love for the Mission community, our shared experience in developing leadership among low-income youth and families, the excellence Loco Bloco brings to arts programming and performance, and the expertise Jamestown brings to academic enrichment, sports and youth development, coupled with our long history of mutual collaboration can result in a better, stronger, more efficient and sustainable organization made up of Loco Bloco and Jamestown.

Programs now include Arts instruction, performance and production educational enrichment, academic tutoring, sports, leadership development, employment, counseling, and parent programs. Throughout these programs, Jamestown aims to provide all participants with the highest-quality youth development experience. This approach builds young people's resilience as they face their daily challenges and supports their natural inclination to pursue their own growth into healthy, productive young adults. Our work focuses on the innate assets of youth to develop their leadership and ability to challenge discrimination and oppression and to bring about change in their communities.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

Jamestown Arts Education and Loco Bloco are currently seeking practicing artists to teach at our community school sites and for Loco Bloco at Brava and other San Francisco, Bay Area locations for the school year of 2023-2024 classes as part of our Arts Ed programming and Loco Bloco programming. The ideal candidate will be motivated, energetic, have a strong professional background, and a passion for teaching in a community setting.

- Ensure programs embody Jamestown's Core Values and provide a safe and supportive environment for youth participants
- Exhibit appropriate behavior for an intergenerational space and accept and embrace the role as a mentor for our youth and young adults
- Provide an arts instruction at community sites
- Collaborates with other Artists at Jamestown and creates specific works for annual events, ensemble performances or school site celebrations however appropriate according to the individual Artist's art skill
- Supervise and ensure the safety and welfare of participants at all times. Keep youth students engaged and create a classroom culture of respect & participation
- Communicate regularly with Supervisor and Jamestown Staff
- Comply with Jamestown Community Center policies and procedures, and laws pertaining to the operation of Jamestown Community Center
- Responsible for taking attendance of class and submitting it on time on to ArtsEd Assistant/direct supervisor on a weekly base

- Creating weekly lesson plans for class/workshops
- Maintain confidentiality and compliance with all laws regarding privacy of youth, their families and staff.

- At least three (3) years documented study with masters or arts education in a specific art form.
- Minimum 2 years of experience teaching youth and adults
- Experience in creating written lesson plans and curriculum
- Excellent organizational & time management & communication skills.
- Self-sufficient in managing job obligations and schedule.
- Proven ability to work with people from a variety of different ethnic, socio-economic, educational, religious, sexual orientation and generational backgrounds.
- Experience with low income youth and families
- Fluent in another language besides English is preferred.
